The Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists (CAOT) is leading a new national initiative — the *Internationally Educated Occupational Therapists: Web-Based Navigation Supports* project — funded by Health Canada's Health Care Policy and Strategies Program (HCPSP). This project will create online tools and resources to help internationally educated occupational therapists (IEOTs) navigate the licensure process and successfully join Canada's occupational therapy workforce.
